Kanawayihetaytan Askiy is a uniquely designed program developed in collaboration with First Nations. It is focused on providing a broad range of topic areas specific to the management of lands and resources on federal reserve lands.

The program provides students a foundation of scientific and traditional knowledge. Students are prepared for careers in governance, management, administration and leadership roles.

To accommodate professional work lives, the Kanawayihetaytan Askiy program provides a blended learning method of classroom, online and field studies.



## **PROGRAM OPTIONS**

#### Kanawayihetaytan Askiy Certificate

This certificate examines basic environmental, legal and economic aspects of land and resource management in Indigenous communities. Students travel to Saskatoon three times a year for two weeks and work from their home for the duration of their studies.

Completion of this certificate meets requirements for Level Two: Technical Training of the National Aboriginal Land Managers Association's (NALMA) Professional Lands Management Certification program. Visit www.nalma.ca for more info.

#### **Diploma in Indigenous Lands Governance**

This diploma provides students with a broad background in governance, management, administration and political science as they relate to Indigenous communities.

### Diploma in Indigenous Resource Management

This diploma provides students with a broad background in resource management for Indigenous communities.

The diploma programs have two entry options. Students can now enter the diploma programs directly from high school or they can complete the Kanawayihetaytan Askiy certificate first before laddering in.
